

TO START

- 1) Tribe is a RADIO PMR 446 transceiver system that permits group communication by talking one at a time and with the best qualitative level offered by radio technology.
- 2) You may need a short period to get acquainted with the product if you have never made use of radio appliances of this kind.
- 3) Tribe is NOT an intercom device as Interphone F4 / Interphone F3 which allow simultaneous conversation between two users. To communicate in group is necessary for each rider to have Tribe.
- 4) Tribe is a voice activation hands-free device which does not require push button use while riding. Tribe, when connected to Interphone F4 or F3, must be tested while riding.
- 5) Voice activation function (VOX) requires about 1,4 seconds. Pronounce any word (ex: your own name) to activate the function. The first pronounced word for voice activation (VOX) will not be heard by receivers.
- 6) Once activated the connection is needful to talk with continuity, in fact a pause over 2 seconds will automatically end the communication.
- 7) Your own hearing volume is automatically leveled by your speaking volume: at first use raise your voice once or utter a short yell.
- 8) A double beep signals the end of the speech and notifies users that the line is free.
- 9) Is advisable to deactivate all Bluetooth/radio devices in proximity while effecting the initial pairing procedure. Having chosen the channel, also select a subchannel on all devices to improve conversation quality.
- 10) To obtain the best performance from Tribe use a handlebar holder such as SMSMARTPHONE, since if utilized close to the body, in some cases, quality and transmission range could be limited.
